

#### Ham Loaf

2 eggs - (beat in large bowl)
l cup milk
l cup dry bread crumbs
1/4 tsp. pepper



Add the above to eggs and stir together

1 1/2 lb.ham-fully cooked, ground 1/2 lb. ground pork

Add to above and mix well

Shape into loaf and place in 8" x 4" x 2 1/2" pan.
Bake at 350 for 30 minutes.

Glaze - 1/3 cup packed brown sugar
1/4 cup vinegar
1/2 tsp. dry mustard
2 tablespoons water

Mix together well and spoon over loaf. Continue to bake loaf for about 40 minutes, occasionally basting with the glaze.

### Spectacular Specs



Autumn comes and brings the harvest, guaranteeing food to eat;


As the fruit of summer's bounty waits on pantry shelves replete.
