Apple Raisin Coffee Cake

1/2 cup shortening
 1 1/2 cup sugar
 Cream together in a large mixing bowl
 1 egg - add to above and beat well
 3 cups all purpose flour
 3 tsp baking powder
 1/2 tsp salt
 1 cup milk
 Add to above and beat well
 Stir in 1 cup raisins. Put in 9" x 13" greased pan. Peel 2 baking apples and slice thinly. Spread over top of batter. Combine 1 tsp ground cinnamon with 2 tbsp of sugar and sprinkle over apples. Bake at 350 degrees for 35-45 minutes or until cake is done. May be served warm with ice cream or whipped cream.

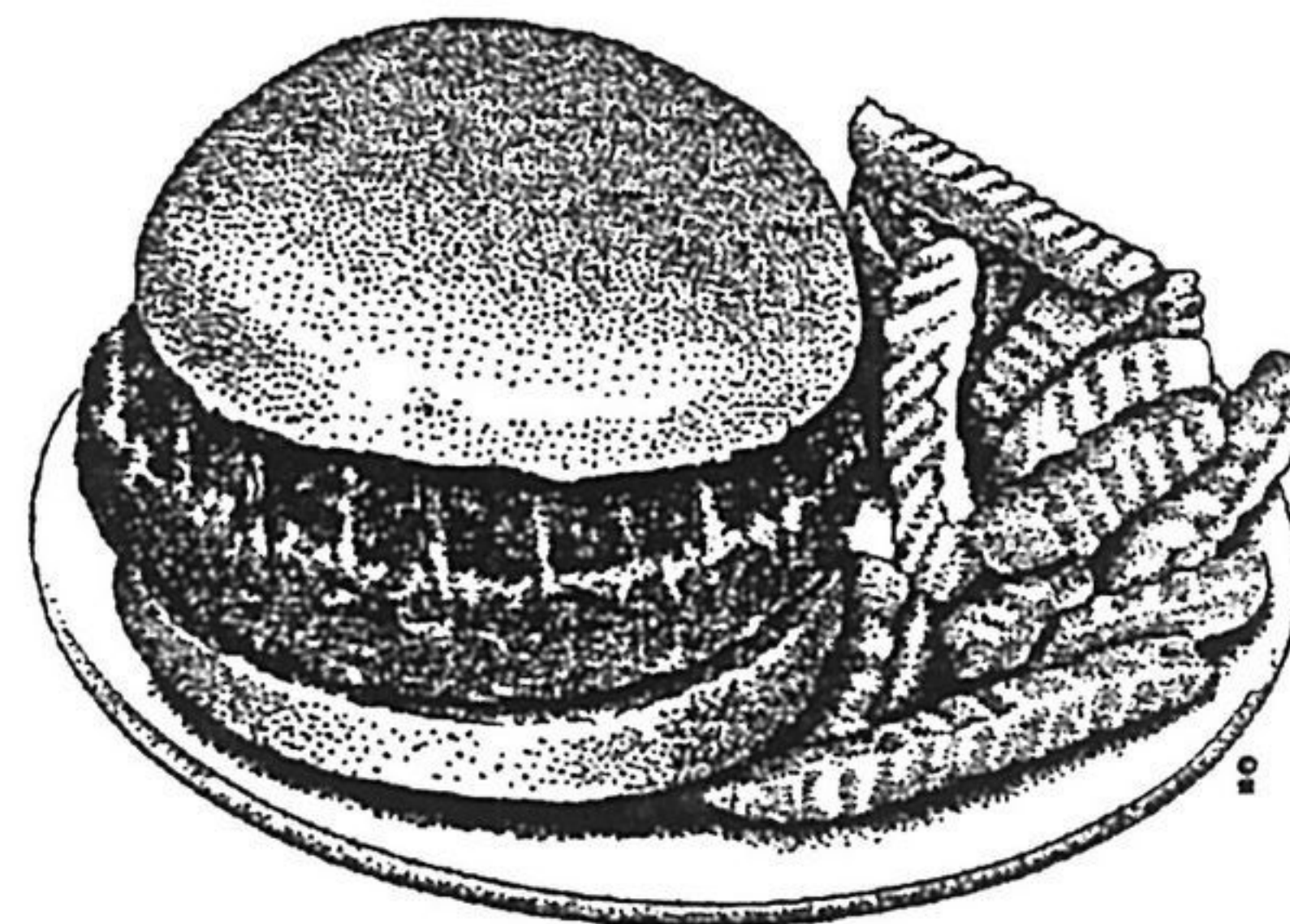
