Sweet Marie Bars

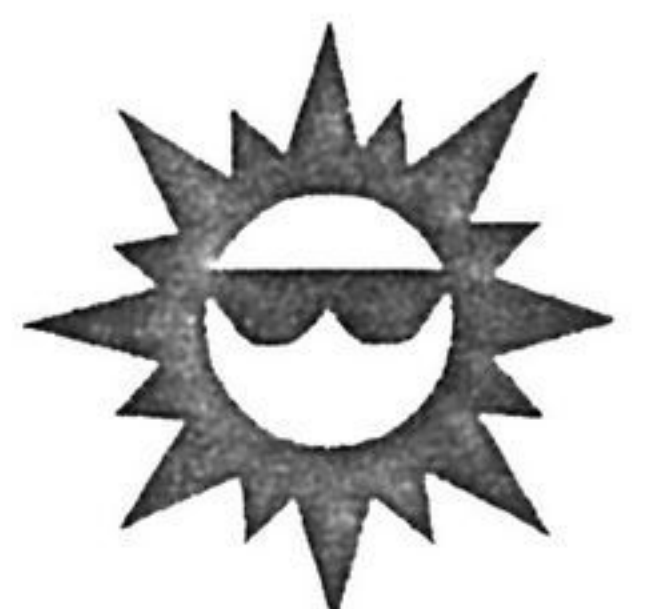
