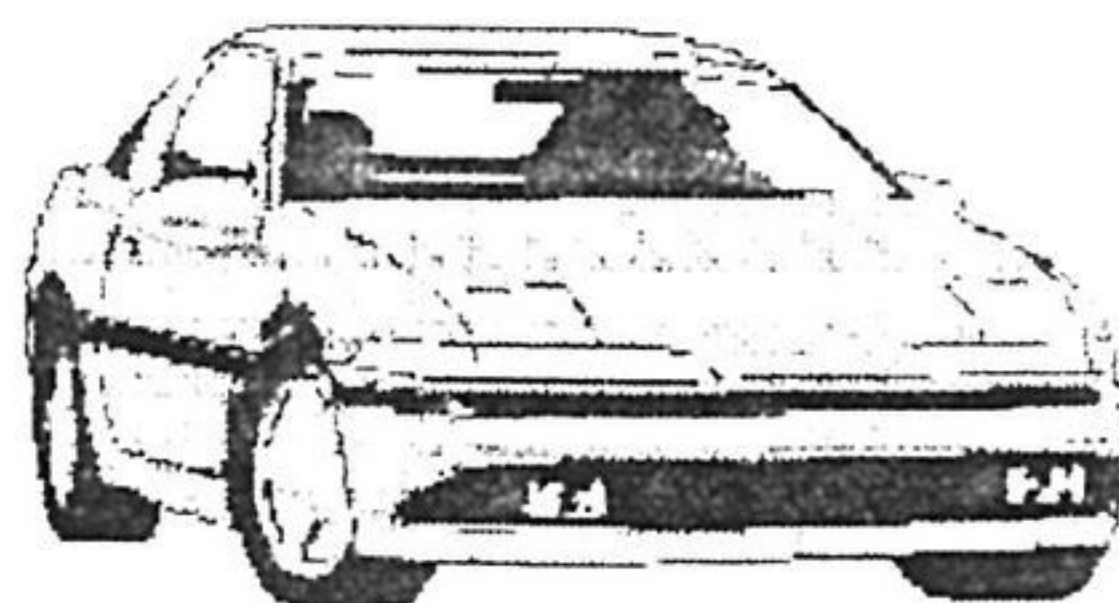
Lions and Tigers and Books! Oh My!

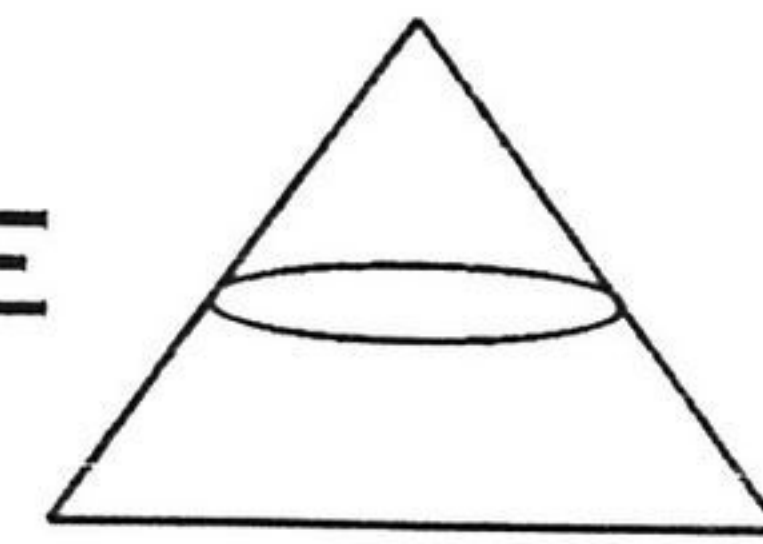
