

CRESSY REGION ENVIRONMENTAL EVALUATION KO-ALITION

Dear Neighbour

We are attempting to gather together a group of concerned Cressy Region residents to pursue the well-being of our neighbourhood.

Our immediate concern is the condition of our water... creek, cove and lake, which boarders on the Hay Bay Genetics Pig Farm. Initially, we are stunned by the fact that this factory farm exists immediately adjacent to a designated "Provincially Significant Wetlands" whose effluent may run directly into Cressy swamp, Cressy creek, Prinyers Cove and Lake Ontario.

We are fully aware that we have the privilege of residing in a rural area, and expect to co-exist with family farms, which have been in this area for many years. However, we cannot accept the possibility that the existing Pig Farm, if not presently then may in the near future, pollute the waters from which many of us draw our drinking water.

History has shown that too often our government has allowed pollution of various sorts to go unchecked until it is too late. Many years and dollars are wasted on clean-ups that could have been put to better use had we moved early enough to prevent these tragedies.

We are not against farming in the community, in fact that environment is why many of us moved to the area. We are simply concerned with the possibility of our water being polluted by a large industrial agricultural business.

Town Hall in Waupoos. We will have the opportunity to
hear Elizabeth May, Executive Director of the Sierra
Club of Canada, express her concerns on this topic.
