


Milford Community Friendship Circle

Gillian Parker's contest caused some controversy as you were to make words with sounds that said "egg". Not everyone pronounced them the same way.


The afternoon was brought to a pleasant closing with lunch supplies by Marg Crouse and Merle Evans who were thanked by Marg Ceh.
