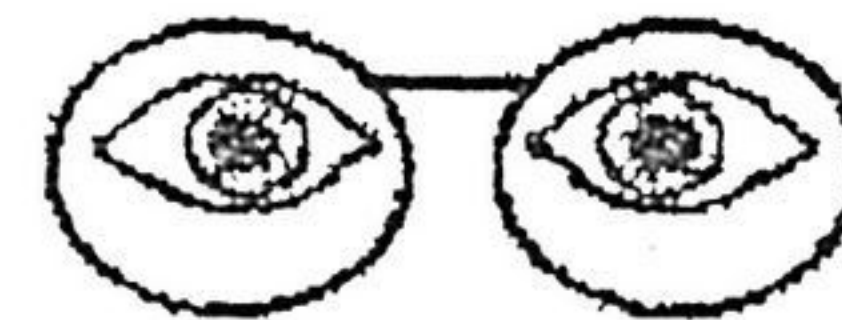
Closing remarks by our President were - I figure when my husband comes home from work, if the kids are still alive, then I've done my job. Courtesy of Phyllis Diller.
