These are all motivational factors for the upcoming photography show by students at Prince Edward Learning Centre. "It all started because I was looking for something fun to do with our students. I like photography, so it was a nice opportunity to share that with them", says Lori Farrington, Special Projects Coordinator at the Learning Centre. "Originally I wrote asking Kodak for help with funding, but before I could mail the letter off, it occurred to me...Prince Edward Arts Council! Since part of the mandate of the Arts Council is to bring the arts to new groups of people, then this would be perfect. Typically our students are not interested in art. I wonder if that is because they aren't necessarily exposed to it. We encourage them to attend Art in the County every year, and they always enjoy it and have definite opinions and tastes. I wanted to build on that and ask them to actually do some creating. We have done crafts before, but this was something completely new."

"We are always looking for new niches in the community and the ability to bring the Arts into areas where they might not be seen. The Prince Edward Learning Centre provides us with a fantastic opportunity to let people explore the Arts so the fit seemed almost obvious." says Pat Larkin, chair of the Arts Council.
