laris Institute. Both have done extensive research on the politics of this issue and the ways that science has been used by our federal government and biotech multinationals to promote genetically engineered foods.

Here are some of the specifics that Sharratt and Kuyek will be addressing.

- *Are genetically modified foods rigorously tested for health and safety?
- *Are regulations properly applied and public information available?
- *Who decides what research is done and who pays for it?
- *Who is promoting GMO's and why?
- *What are the effects of GM technology on biodiversity and food security?
- *What are the larger implications for society from the current push for GMO's?
- *Is genetic engineering of all our food crops and livestock inevitable?
- *What can we do about our concerns?

These are urgent questions for farmers and consumers alike, the press and public are cordially invited to attend and participate in the meeting.
