Sat Nov 7 Froze again last night, quite alot harder than Thurs night. Ploughed again all day. Mother & I went over to town. John Murphy went over with us. Lloyd

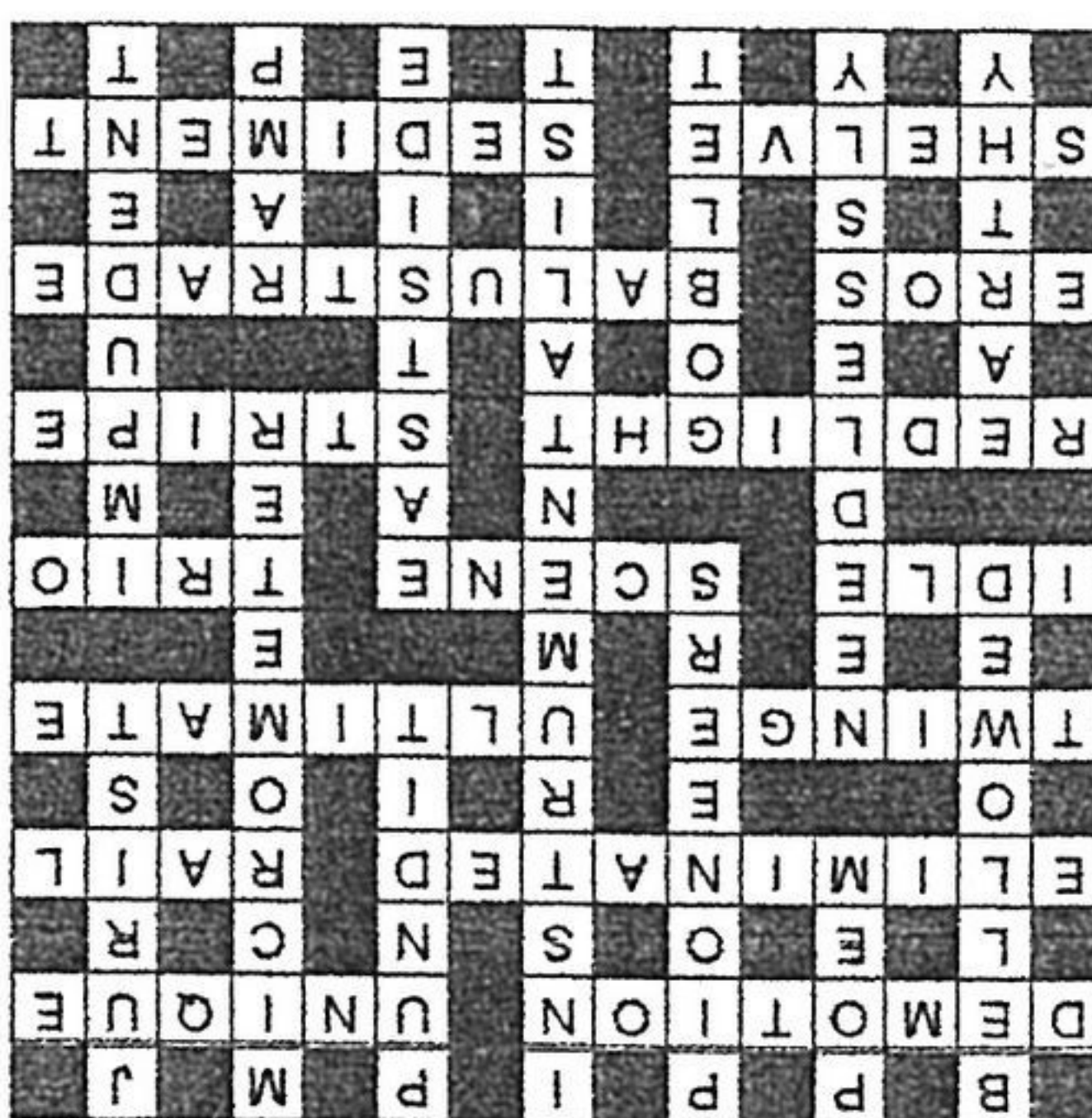
