And sent a gift to days beyond my sight.

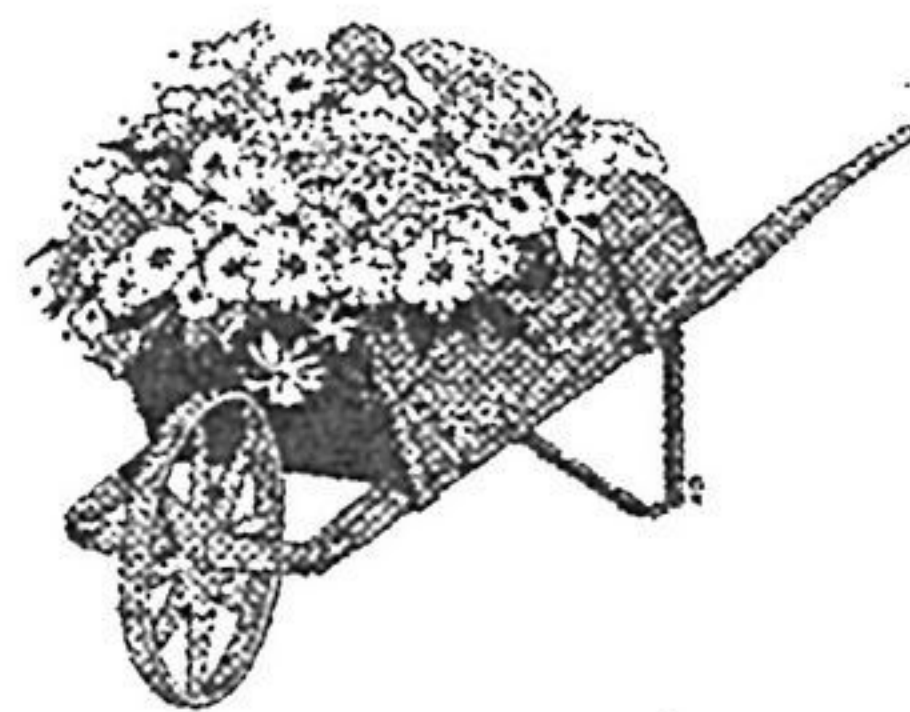
