Spanish Rice

1/4 cup butter or margarine - Melt in saucepan
Add 2 cups uncooked instant rice and stir until browned.
Add and bring to boil
 1 can(14 1/2 oz.) tomatoes with liquid, chopped
 1 cup boiling water
 2 beef bouillon cubes
 1 medium onion, chopped
 1 clove garlic, minced
 1 bay leaf
 1 tsp. sugar
 1 tsp. salt
 1/4 tsp. pepper

Reduce heat, cover and simmer for 10-15 minutes until liquid is absorbed and rice is tender. Remove bay leaf before serving.
