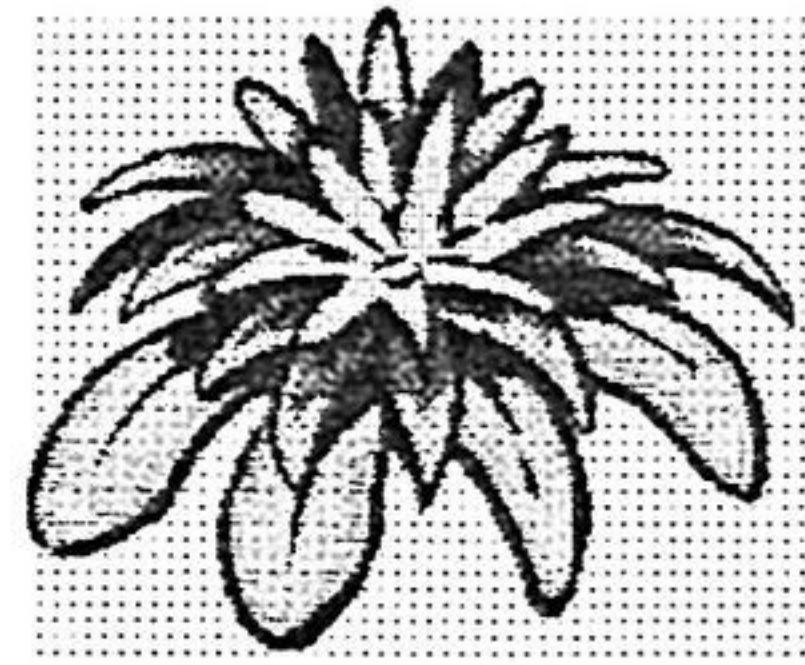


Milford in Bloom
