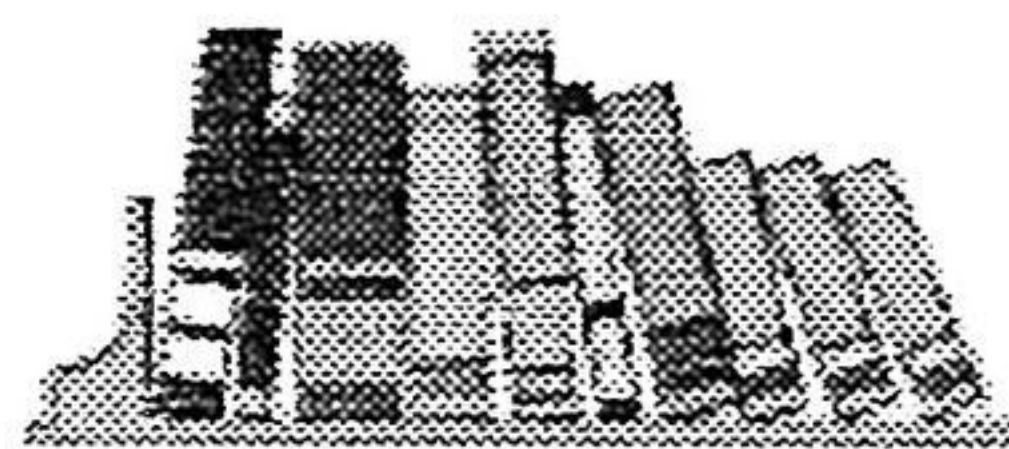


LIBRARY NOTES

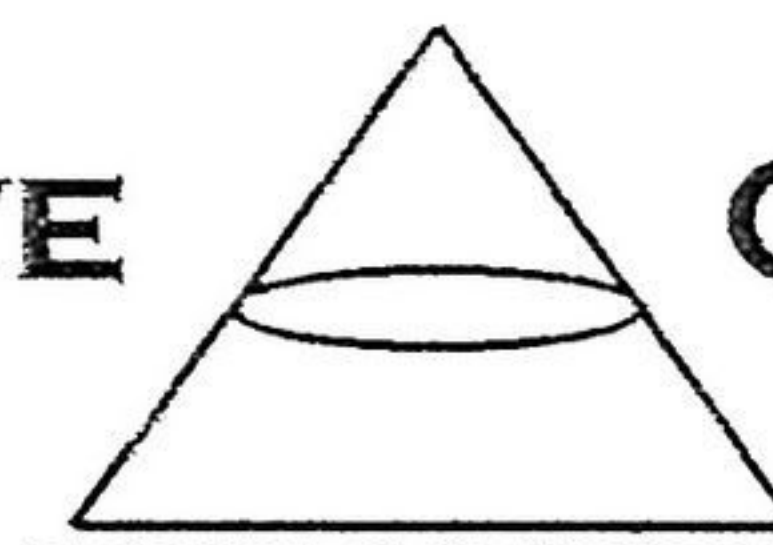
The following interruptions in service will occur from mid-September to mid-October:
