
For the Birds

Launches online January 15, 2019 and features PEC poets and photographers

The Prince Edward Point Bird Observatory (PEPtBO) will publish a 46-page, full colour poetry chapbook <u>For the Birds</u> on January 15, 2019 on its website at www.peptbo.ca.

With words and photos, this unique celebration of birdlife in the County contains winning entries from PEPtBO's first poetry contest, complemented by images taken by local photographers Ian Dickinson and Hélène Tremblay. Poems by Brian L. Flack and Walter H. Watt placed first in the contest.


PEPtBO intends to hold an award ceremony and public reading from <u>For the Birds</u> in conjunction with programming around the spring migration period.
