## **OUR HISTORY**

The Milford Fall Fair began in 1946 to celebrate the return of the South Marysburgh residents who had gone off to fight in World War II. It has been run since the beginning by a board composed of members of our community. Originally, the fair took place on Wednesday afternoons and many of



our residents will remember the township's school children parading into the fairgrounds.

In 1984, the board decided to move the Fair to Saturday afternoon as it is today – always under sunny skies. According to local legend, it never rains on the Milford Fair!
