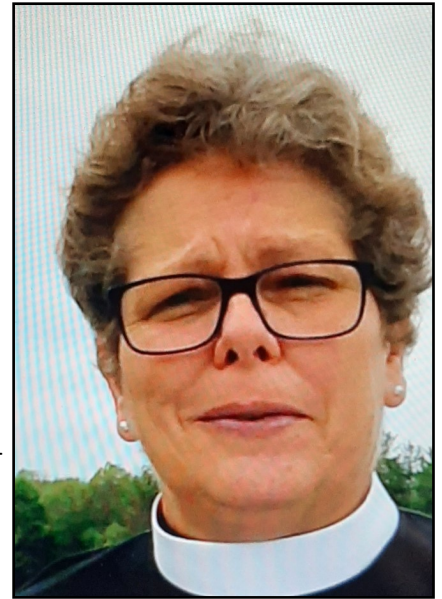
service, most recently in the Stirling, Roslin, Marlbank and Land O Lakes areas.
