Combine the above in small bowl and set aside Heat 2 tsp. olive oil in skillet at medium heat, add 4 large boneless, skinless chicken breasts and cook 2 or 3 minutes until browned on each side. Add apple juice mixture, cover and simmer 5 to 8 minutes or till done. Remove chicken and keep warm. Gently boil remaining liquid till slightly reduced in volume. Mix 1/4 cup light sour cream, 1tsp. honey and 1 tsp. cornstarch, stir into skillet until sauce is bubbly and thickened. Pour over warm chicken and serve immediately
