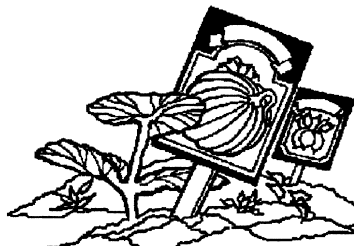

Pumpkin Pie

2 1/2 cups of Pumpkin puree
4 eggs
1 1/2 cups brown sugar
1 1/2 tsp ginger
2 tsp cinnamon
1/4 tsp nutmeg
1/4 cup lemon juice
1 tsp salt
1 2/3 cups evaporated milk

Blend everything except pumpkin. Then add pumpkin. Mix well. Pour into uncooked pie shells. Makes 2-4 pies.

Bake at 400 for 30 mins.
