Fourth Kerosene Lamp Ends 2007 Season



Tom Leighton's distinguished career crosses a broad spectrum of musical accomplishments from orchestrating for the Kingston Symphony, the new musical Ann and Gilbert, The Eisler Singers as well as performing in folk festivals and folks clubs around the world.
