

Regent Theatre Focus's on Youth

During the month of March the Regent Theatre will focus its LIVE presentations on the younger generation.

On Tuesday March 4th at noon, Tribal Productions will be performing their much-acclaimed comedy **"The Complete Works of William Shakespeare – Abridged"** for a special schools audience. This tour de force is 97-minute long and features 37 plays by the Bard performed with only 3 actors playing all the roles. This special performance is sold out but the entire community can see this contemporary comedy at 7.30pm on the same day. Tickets are \$25 for adults and \$10 for students under 18 years of age.

Theatre Beyond Words, Canada's Internationally renowned visual theatre company brings its unique production **"Journey Behind The Mask"**, to the Regent stage on Saturday March 22nd at 7.30pm. Tickets are \$20 for adults and \$10 for students under 18 years of age. Earlier in the day at 1pm, the company members will conduct a special workshop. The various kinds of masks will be demonstrated and participants will have the opportunity to wear the masks in guided exercises making this workshop a unique experience for all ages. The cost of the workshop is \$20 and space is limited to 20 participants.
