Audacious Anglicans

On Sunday, June 15^{th,} Audacious Anglicans - Heroes of the Anglican Communion, a book documenting the lives of a number of Anglican women and men who have greatly affected the world, will have its Canadian launching. This event will be sponsored by our sister church in the Parish of Marysburgh, St. John's, Waupoos from 4 to 6 p.m. at the home of one of the books co-authors, Gerald T. Rayner in Waupoos.

The book is a compilation of articles more biographical in content than theological. The chapters were originally published as individual articles under the same title in past issues of Anglican Episcopal World, the official magazine of the Anglican Communion. When the magazine suspended publication earlier this year and at the urging of Canon James N. Rosenthal, its editor, Gerald Rayner along with his co-author, Dr. Robert Moore of Ottawa, decided to pursue their original idea they had in the year 2000 of writing a book.

Audacious Anglicans will feature a wide range of persons. Some of those highlighted are Bishop Desmond Tutu, the Canadian Henry Budd, the first First Nation person in North America to be ordained in the

Anglican Church. Bishop Jacques (James) Holly, one time bishop of Haiti, William Wilberforce, two women Li Tim Oi priested in Hong Kong 44 and Una Kroll priested in Wales in 1997 and scientist and priest John Polkinghorne. As well as these and other individuals, there are three chapters giving the histories of 3 organizations; SAMS, The Church Army (Kenya) and the Melanesian Brotherhood.

The authors will be present for the book launching at the Rayner home on County Road 13 near the intersection of County Road 8.

The book will have a second launching this summer in England at the Lambeth Conference, the gathering of the Bishops of the Anglican Communion that is held every ten years.
