Thanks to all who brought food for the food bank!

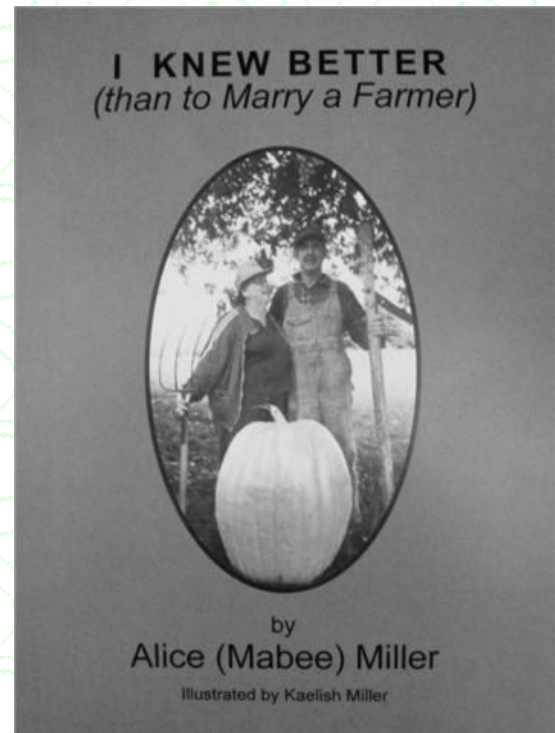
