Maple Cinnamon French Toast

Ingredients

1 loaf French Bread, cubed • 1/2 cup bacon bits • 4 ounces cream cheese • 1 cup whipping cream • 1/2 cup maple syrup • 6 eggs • 1 teaspoon vanilla 1 teaspoon cinnamon

Place bread cubes evenly in greased 9 x 13 casserole dish. Sprinkle bacon bits over bread.

In a large bowl, beat cream cheese until fluffy. Gradually beat in cream and syrup until well combined. Beat in eggs, vanilla, and cinnamon. Pour over bread, pressing bread into mixture. Cover with tin foil and chill overnight.

Let casserole dish stand at room temperature for 30 minutes. Bake at 375° for 25 minutes. Remove foil covering and make for another 18-22 minutes until set and brown. Serve warm with syrup.
