**Leveraging a White Cake Mix to Ramp Up the Taste and Seasonal Flare**

Thinking ahead to the holidays, if you're looking for an easy way to make a white cake special on a quick turnaround, here's a recipe to try.

This yields one 11 X 13 pan, two eight inch rounds or 24 medium cupcakes and one eight inch round.

**Ingredients**

- 1 package white cake mix (suggest French vanilla) – 375 g (18.25 ounces)
- 1 cup all-purpose flour – 240 ml
- 1 cup of white sugar (you can cut back the amount of sugar a bit) – 240 grams
- ¾ teaspoon salt
- 1 1/3 cups of water – 320 ml
- 1 cup sour cream (can use low fat) – 240 grams
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1 teaspoon liquor or almond extract
