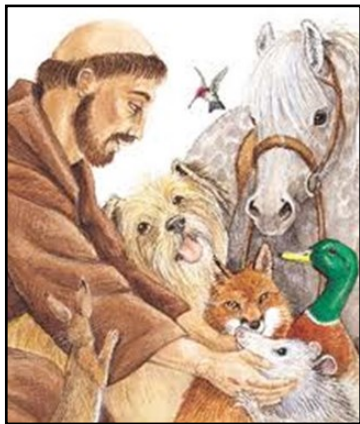


Roots and Wings St. Philip's Anglican Church
