

SCHREIBER MEDICAL CENTRE

The Schreiber Medical Centre was officially opened in September of 1975 with many citizens attending. The building was formerly the post office built in 19. The Council turned it over to the town for a medical centre hoping to obtain a resident doctor or doctors to remain in the town. They felt that it would attract doctors when proper facilities were provided.

It was renovated to provide a doctors suite of rooms, office, accommodation for a District Health Unit, rooms for a dentist and anoptometrist and headquarters for am ambulance. Jack Stokes MPP. Reeve Harold McParland held the ribbon for Doctor Miro Spacek to cut it for the opening ceremonies.
