Carried.

Moved by Norman Lickers and seconded by Clarence Jamieson, that this Council accept the recommendation of the Finance Committee to requisition for a Grant from the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development for the following programs for the Fiscal Year, April 1, 1970, to March 31, 1971: BASIC PROGRAM, NON-BASIC, & PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION.

Request is hereby made for the total amount of grants requested, in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$35,900.00) be deposited in the bank account of the Six Nations of the Grand River Band, Toronto Dominion Bank, 112 Dalhousie Street, Brantford, Ontario. Carried.

Moved by Norman Lickers and seconded by Clarence Jamieson, that this Council hereby resolve that the management of sufficient funds from our Revenue Account for the administration of the Fairgrounds and the Ferry be transferred to the Band under Section 68 of the Indian Act. Carried.

Moved by Mitchell Sandy and seconded by Ronald Monture, that this Council forward a letter to Mr. & Mrs. Henry (Jack) Peters, R. R. #1, Ohsweken, Ontario congratulating them on celebrating 60 years of married life together. Carried.

Moved by Norman Lickers and seconded by Mrs. Rena Hill, that this Council approve payment of the Finance Accounts, as presented. Carried.

Moved by William White and seconded by Mrs. Rena Hill, that this Council authorize Nina Burnham to approach ex-Councillor Frank W. Montour to accept the position of Project Manager for the Six Nations Sanitation Incentive Program. Carried.
