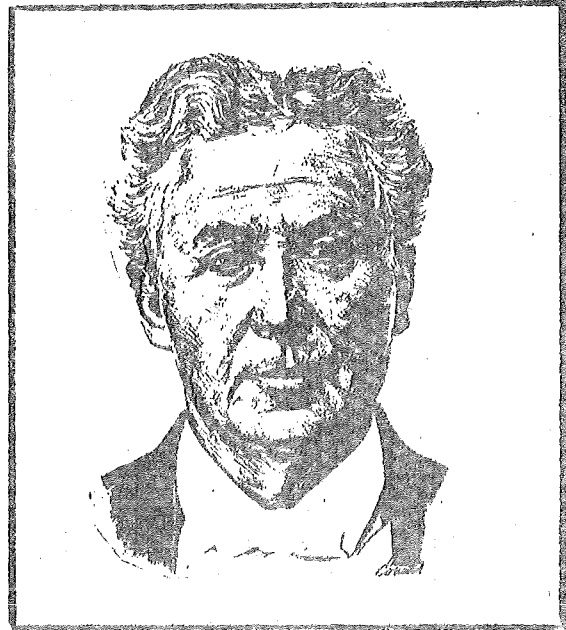


ORONHYTEKA

The Mohawk name of Dr. Peter Martin, translated, is Burning Cloud. Born in 1841 at Martin settlement on the Grand River, his burning ambition was to get the education needed to become a doctor of medicine.

In his 20th year the people of the Six Nations chose Oronhyteka to present an address of welcome to the Prince, later Edward VII of Great Britain, who learned of Oronhyteka's ambition and suggested that he go to Oxford University in England. He studied for three years with Dr. Henry Accland King's physician.

A listing of Dr. Cronhyteka's interests is long, but he is best known for his life long study of fraternal organizations.
