BRANTFORD INJUNCTION SETTLED

Six Nations land defenders Ruby and Floyd Montour being filmed by police during a protest stopping further development on Six Nations lands. In 2009 the City of Brantford won an injunction to stop Onkwehon:we protests, resulting in a Superior Court of Ontario decision requiring Ruby and Floyd Montour, Clive Garlow, Charlie Green, David Martin, Hazel Hill and the HDI, John Doe, Jane Doe, persons unknown, and HDI lawyer Aaron Detlor to pay the city costs of \$375,000. On Monday night the City of Brantford accepted a surprise offer of \$175 000 from some of the appellants to resolve the issue. It is unclear who exactly is paying the costs of the settlement.
