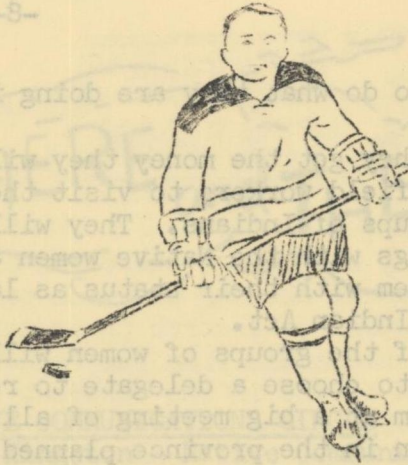

BUTCH HILL LEADS STARS TO WIN WITH FOUR

OHSWEKEN.....NOVEMBER 22, 1973

The Smoothtown Bruins have finally tasted defeat at the hands of the Mohawk Stars. The Stars waltzed away with the game 9-1.

The indefatigable effort of Bill Montour and brother Frank, was not enough to carry the other players who played like a long-tailed cat in a room full of rocking chairs.

The Bruins lone goal was scored by Kenny Maracle and assisted by Cooge Smith in the first period.

Gaylord Powless started the Stars on their little scoring spree at 12:35 and was assisted by Paul Henhawk. Mr. Butch scored two of his four goals in this period. Gaylord Powless and Paul Henhawk assisted Butch on these goals. Jack Hill was assisted by Morgan Green on the fourth goal of this period at 1:50.

One penalty was called, against the Bruins.

Two goals were scored in the second, one by Paul Henhawk assist Gaylord Powless and one unassisted by Butch Hill.

The second game of the evening was played between the B.C. Jets and the S.S. Spoilers, the Spoilers winning 10-8.

John Monture, assisted by Woody Porter put the Spoilers ahead 29 seconds after the start of the game. He also scored one unassisted at 18:43 giving them an early 2-0 lead. Roger Martin assisted by Sy Johnson put the Jets back into the game at the 16 minute mark. Rick Anderson assisted by Cliff Lickers tied it up at 5:45. Cam Hill broke the tie at 4:17 assisted by Lorne General. With 1:09 remaining in the period Rick Anderson managed to score unassisted, ending the first in a 3-3 tie.

Three penalties were called against the Spoilers, one against the Jets.

Spoilers' John Monture scored his hat-trick 11 seconds after the second period started. He was assisted by Satch Martin. Lorne General scored one assisted by brother Terry who scored twice unassisted. Cec Martin also scored his goal unassisted. Jets' Rick Anderson also scored his hat-trick this period. He was assisted by Dave Davey. Dave Davey scored one assisted by Rick Anderson and assisted on the goal by Roger Martin.

The Jets received no penalties this period while the Spoilers were called on two.

Four goals were scored in the third two for the Jets and two for the Spoilers. Jets goals were scored by Greg Fraser unassisted and Darby Thomas assisted by Rick Anderson. Spoilers goals went to Lorne General assist Terry, and John Porter assist Brian Martin.
