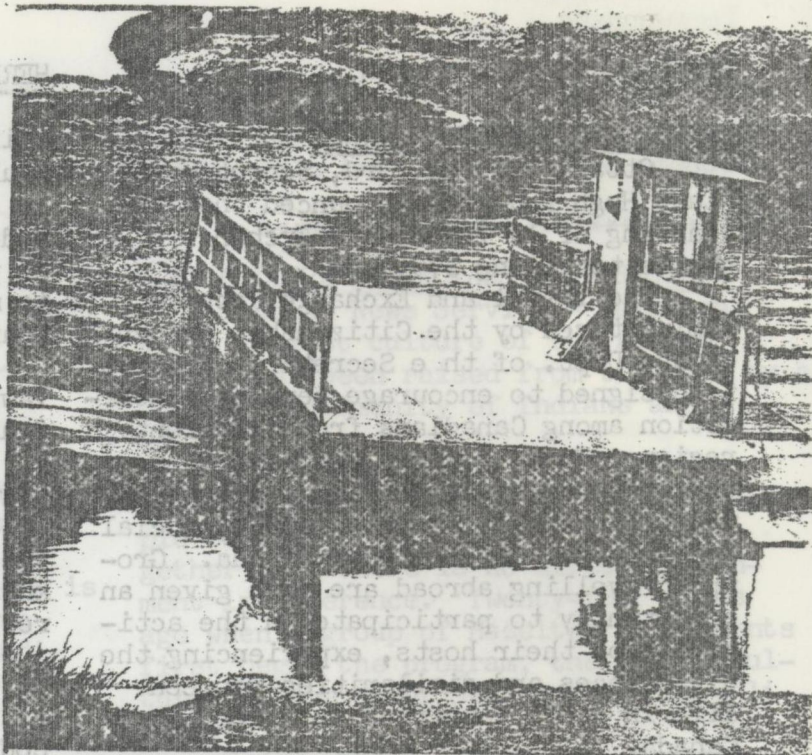


SIX NATIONS FERRY

The Six Nations Ferry is located north of Ohsweken, Ont. crossing the Grand River and servicing the Six Nations Reserve which is situated on both sides of the River.

During the summer months the Ferry creates easy access to Chiefswood and No. 54 Highway on the north side of the River.

The Ferry was recently rebuilt to accommodate the increased amount of traffic across the River. Each year it is in operation from May to October.
