CANADIAN INDIAN ART 74

In 1974 the World Craft Council will hold an International Craft Exhibition and Conference in Toronto from mid June through until the end of August. The Royal Ontario Museum, The Canadian Guild of Cranfts and the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development are jointly mounting a National Indian Arts and Crafts Exhibition in conjunction with the activities sponsored by the World Craft Council.

Any artist or craftsman who is of Canadian Indian Ancestry and has been a resident of Canada since January 1, 1970, is eligible. Each entry must be of original or traditional design and executed by the artist/craftsman in Canada. In the event that work is designed and executed by more than one craftsman it must be so labelled.

Traditional crafts in all materials are acceptable, as well as pointings in all media, drawings, engravings, lithographs, and so on. Sculptured objects are also eligible. All entries to become the exclusive property of the Central Marketing Service at the point of purchase.
