

TRIBAL SYMBOLS

On the Six Nations Arena Building you will find Six Symbols which signify the joining of the Six Nations.

The Six Nations Sports & Memorial Cultural Centre (Arena) was officially opened on May 21, 1973.

The Board of Directors for the Arena consists of 12 representatives, 2 from each district of the reserve.

The Arena Committee drew up a constitution and approached Council for support of the project. On April 24, 1972, a sod-turning ceremony was held and construction began that afternoon.
