Clerk: Yes, but it would look better on the wall.

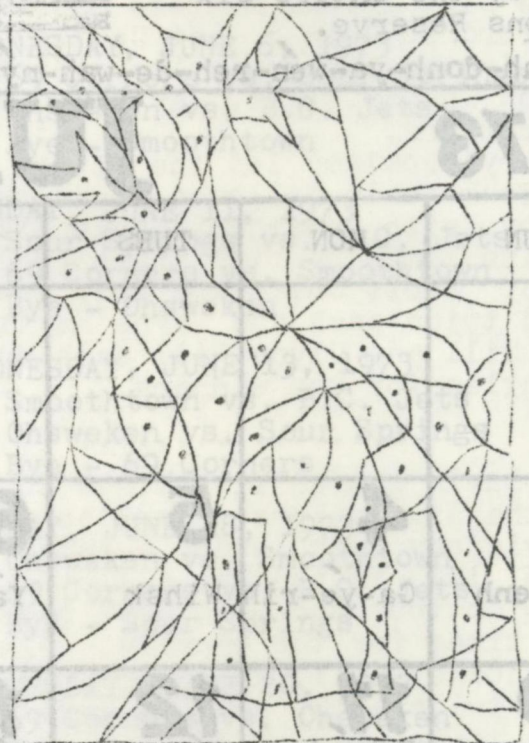
Spring rain, Spring rain,
