NATIVE YOUTH LIASION SPECIALIST PROCRAM From the office of Mr. Ciaccia has come a new program for Native development. This program is designed to send out Native youth to: 1) Help Native communities find funding sources, 2) bring services and goods to the Native communities, and 3) generally improve on the problems in Native communities. This program has had over \$1 million allocated for hiring personnel. It also has the full support of the Dep. of Indian Affairs and Northern Development. A meeting was held in Ottawa with the new personnel to discuss and outline their functions. The total work force is expected to be 33 youths signed to

Wone year contracts. not dans good odd no? It is explained that this program is the "dream" of Mr. Ciaccia, Mr. Biach, and other government employees. The government does seem to feel that this is the appropriate response to all the problems that have been discussed in Ottawa. olidw , ayod maibal of mairolist

Meetings were held in Toronto by some of the National leadership of A.I.M. to discuss & review the program. It was brought out in the A.I.M. meetings that the government's 1969 white paper said, "...services must come through the same channels and from the same government agencies for all Canadians." It is felt by the A.I.M. leaders that, if this program goes through the reserves and communities will be flooded with more L.I.P., OFY, LEAP, metc. programs. As more of these programs come into our communities, the less responsibility the Federal Government and DIA take for honouring the treaties and their commitment to Native people."
