Indians meet habby for their needs aren at the expense of being branded agitators, a Six Nebicos, Enflan said Friday.

James Powleds, employed by the federal government as assistant superintendent of the Perembersiah agency, told the closing session of a three-day meeting of Indian women at Toronto that Andlans tend to be reticent because they are afraid of being branded as sgitalors.

The mesting was organized by The Ganadian Council of Christians and Jews.

Chief Burton Jacobs of Walpola Idland said Indians must try to improve their relations with whice people.

He said some Indians still harbor hatred towards whites because of broken treaties

which left the Indian filled with apathy, distrust and despair.
