get it back, it's ours to start with. And they are going to graciously give 200 acres back?"

Upon questioning further, it was made clear that the CAT team was given a take-it-or-leave-it offer.

"It was that or nothing," said Whitlow. "Take it or leave it, so they went ahead and took the deal and that is where we are at right now."

Bomberry stands behind Elected Council's decision.

"I don't know if it's improper (to use that previous data), but we did the best we can to be fair and ensure we got some land back which is what the people wanted," said Bomberry.

Even though the CAT team makes these agreements, Dale Bomberry, as SAO, has final say and has to agree on every project that is ever agreed on in this region.

The third and final community meeting regarding the already signed McClung, Avalon project deal is set for Thursday, evening, May 24th.
