Maritime provinces exempted Status Indians of GST/ HST, if purchases are made on a reserve or are delivered to a reserve by a vendor or

the vendor's agent. Off re-

serve purchases however, are subject to the HST. To receive the PST exemption, Status Indians must retain their proof of purchase and submit any/all receipts to the province for PST reimbursement.
