TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO ATHLETIC GROUNDS

Scraping and Rolling to be Done at Early Date. Plans for Dressing Rooms.

The Timmins Amateur Athletic Association held a formal session on Friday evening in the Council Chamber with all sports duly represented. It was decided to accept the application of the Timmins Tennis Club for affiliation, and the constitution will be amended accordingly to add the Tennis Club to the clubs making up the Timmins Amateur Athletic Association. The Tennis club will likely put in courts in the south-east corner of the ball grounds,—on the Moneta side,—a part practically never used or usable by other sports. The football field will be moved a little west of its present position. This will permit of the baseball diamond being completely clear of the football field. The Executive of the T.A.A.A. are also to inspect the grounds and make all possible improvements at as early a date as possible. At present it is planned to scrape and roll the grounds. It is believed that this will greatly improve the field for all purposes. The scraper owned by the Township of Tisdale is to be used, and the Dome has kindly agreed also to the loaning of their roller. Thus, with good neighbors and an energetic working executive, there is every hope that the good work started in previous years of improving the athletic grounds will be carried along this year.

The Executive are also planning to erect dressing rooms for sports. Estimates are being made along this line by Hill-Clark-Francis and J. Walsh as to probable costs. The building contemplated would be about 30 feet by 15 feet, and would have two dressing rooms, one that could be used by the football boys and the other by the baseball players. Last year the Timmins Football Club paid \$15.00 a month for a dressing room near the Athletic Grounds. To have such accommodation right on the grounds would suit the football players better and the club would prefer paying rent to the grounds rather than to anyone else supplying less suitable quarters. A dressing room is a necessity for sports such as baseball, lacrosse and football, and the erection of the dressing rooms proposed would be looked upon as a big step forward.

The application of the Girls' Baseball Club for affiliation with the T.A.A.A. was referred to the Timmins Baseball Club as that club is to handle all the baseball in town this year.
