NEW CHRISTMAS CLUB DEVELOPS SAVING HABIT

Ordinary books are not needed in carrying the Christmas Club accounts. The Imperial Bank, Timmins Branch, is using a patented card system, in which the record of payment is made by punching cards. This not only gives the depositor a receipt, but also shows exactly how much has been paid in to date, and does away with any possibility of error.

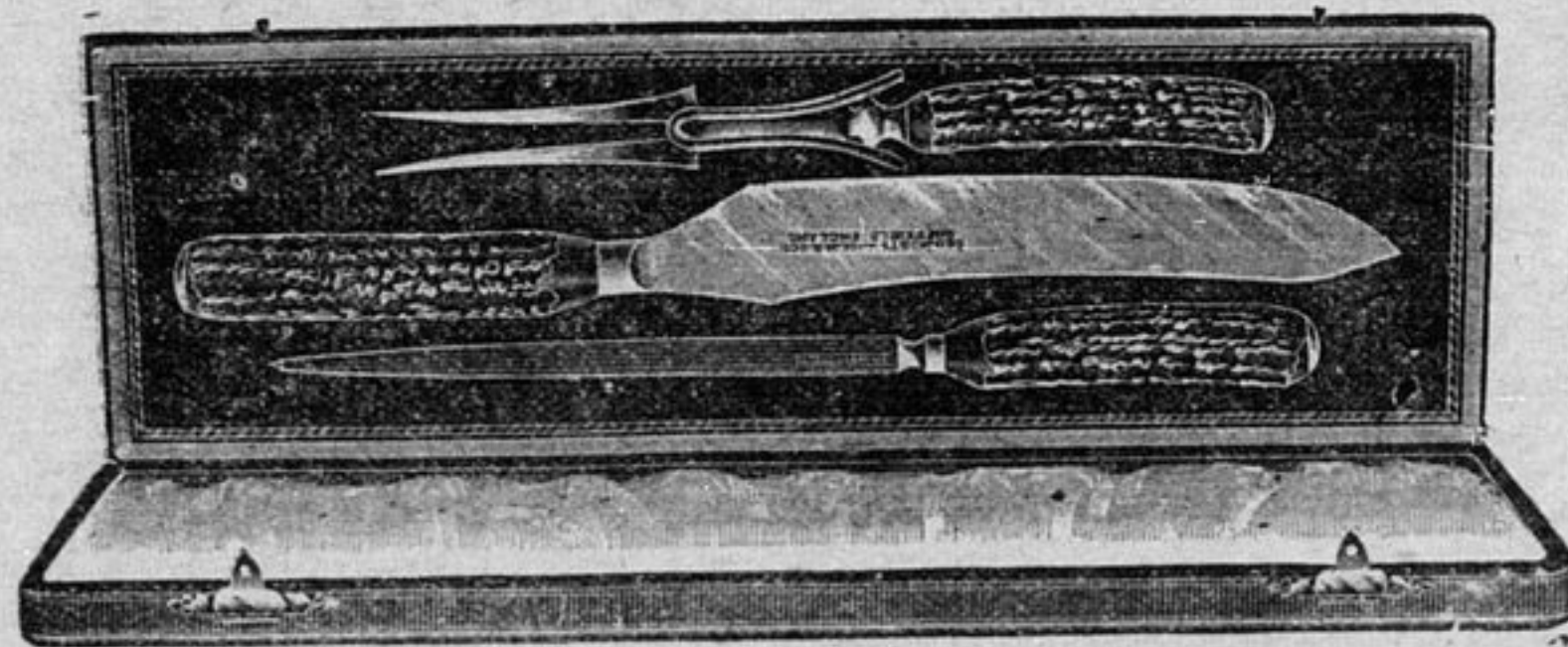

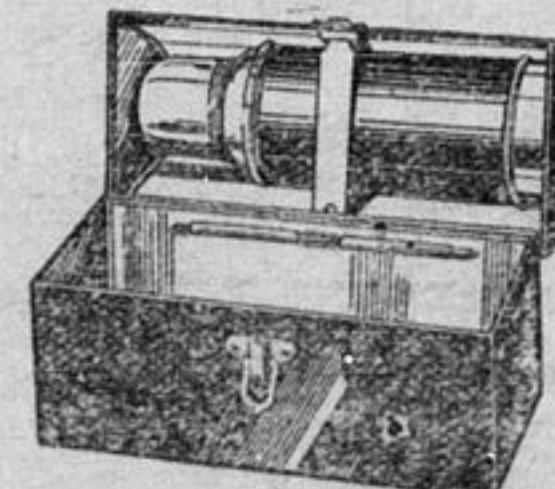

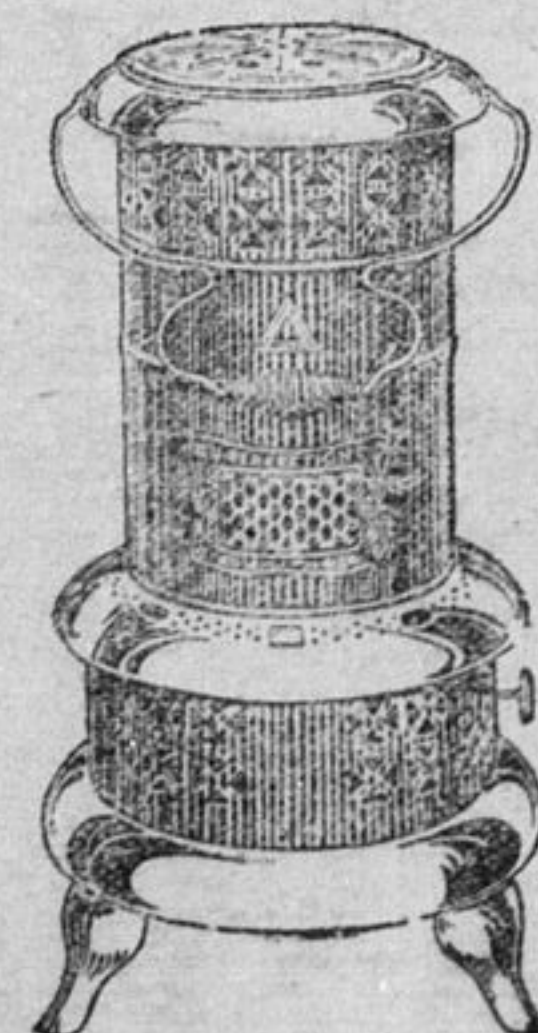
