WILL MINING MACHINERY BE PLACED ON FREE LIST?

New Government Seems So Pledged. Most Should Have Been Free Under "Protection" System.

Although the Liberals refused to make the tariff the issue in the recent Dominion election, and though many of the elected Liberals are professed Protectionists, still the Liberals as a party are more or less pledged to some measure of "free trade," "freer trade," or "tariff for revenue only," or whatever other way you like to express it. Accordingly, there is some interesting speculation as to what will be done about machinery and supplies, etc. of particular interest to the mining industry. Will mining machinery be placed on the free list? Those who wish this question to be answered in the affirmative argue that the revenue from the tariff on mining machinery and supplies is not of very great importance to the Government,—the Government could get along nicely without it. Nevertheless it is a more or less serious handicap to the mining industry, and the percentage of tariff in some cases would mean the difference between profitable mining for some of the smaller concerns and costs that make mining prohibitive. The idea of the Protection system hitherto in force, as implied by the word "Protection," was to protect Canadian manufacturers and industries from foreign competition. Even under this system most of the mining machinery and supplies would be on the free list, as the equipment and materials come here from foreign countries. On the other hand, there are a number of Canadian concerns that would be affected by placing all mining machinery and supplies on the free list and these concerns may naturally be expected to oppose any change in the tariff. The attitude of the new Government in the matter will be watched with much interest.

Up to date the mines themselves have not generally pressed for the taking off of the tariff on machinery and supplies. It is true that one or two mines have advocated the dropping of the duty in these lines, but the mines generally have not taken any concerted action. However there will be general interest in the attitude of the Mackenzie King Government in dealing with this question, in view of the implied pledges in the party platform.

TEARS FROZE ON CHEEKS AS TRAPPER MEETS DEATH

Man Lost Near Bingle Discovered Standing by Tree Frozen to Death.

Word was received last week of the discovery of the body of a trapper named Ricard who had been lost a few days in the bush near Bingle on the Transcontinental east of Cochrane. Ricard was out trapping with an Indian and became lost in the bush. The Indian said that Ricard left to follow a moose. When Ricard failed to return even when night came, the Indian, realizing the futility of attempting alone to find the missing man in the bush, went to Cochrane for assistance. Four fire-rangers returned with the Indian and a thorough search was made. Eventually Ricard was found. He was standing leaning against a tree and there were tears frozen on his eyes and cheeks. He had frozen to death in an attempt to find his way back to the camp. He had no matches with him and had been unable to start a fire so that he could keep warm until another morning came that would enable him once more to reach his companion.

THIS INTERFERES WITH MERRY CHRISTMAS SPIRIT

Provincial Travelling License Inspector Blackwall, formerly license inspector for Temiskaming, but recently given supervision over practically all the north country, has been making things lively, or otherwise, in Kenora. At one place he seized 160 cases of liquor, five cases of beer, one barrel of beer, 60 gallons of brandy, 115 loose bottles of liquor, two gallons of Port Wine, four gallons of Scotch whiskey, and nine barrels of various liquors, each containing 42 gallons. At another place there were a seizure of 34 cases of liquor.

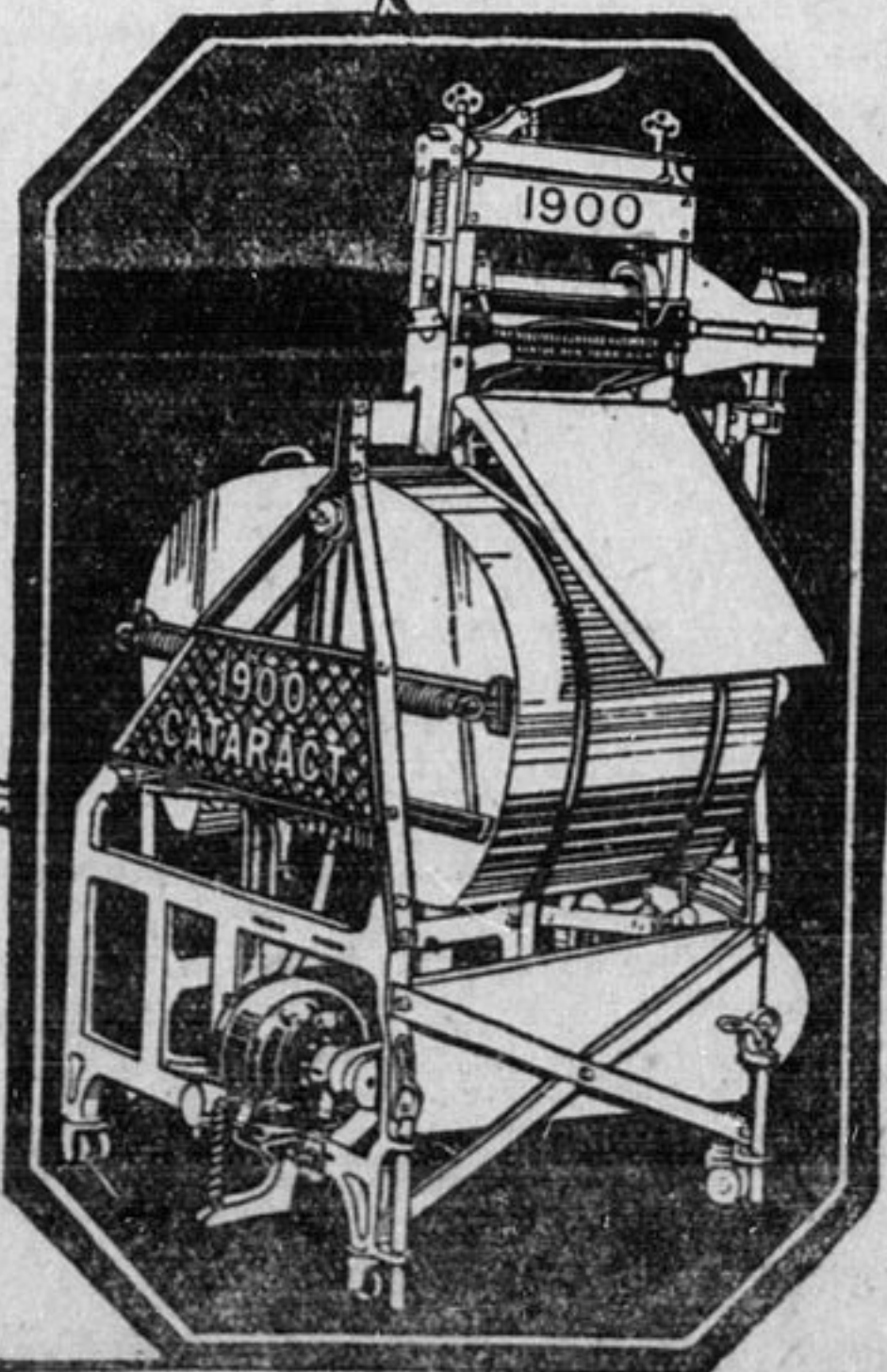

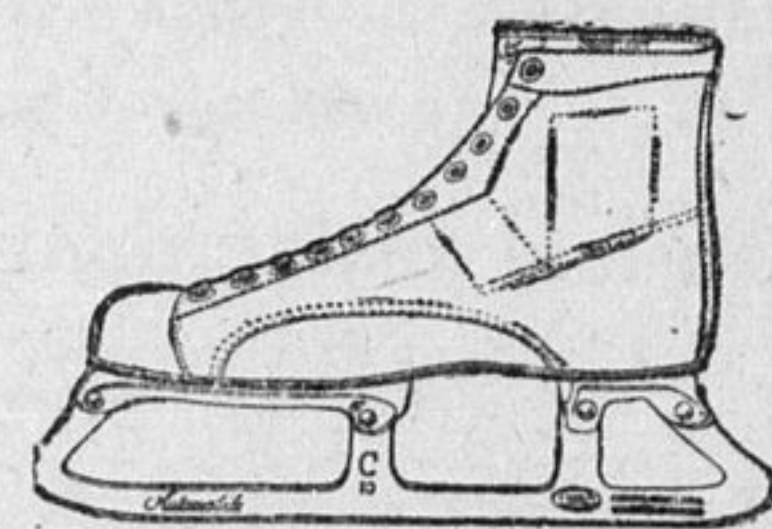
