

In further reference to the Christmas tree question the Forestry Association says it is easy to cut a Spruce or Balsam tree to secure a good Christmas tree without killing the parent tree's growth. The plan is as follows:- 1

"'Cut the tree off just above the lowest whorl of branches and then trim off all other of the remaining branches except one. The latter will grow erect rapidly and gradually estabish itself as the main tree trunk. In this way, a plantation of spruces can be kept producing Christmas trees indefinitely. The plan is in effect in several parts of the United States."

It was also agreed that publicity was of great benefit in securing the protection of investors, and means should be adopted to reach people who ordinarily cannot secure the information that is necessary to protect them.
