**SPECIAL WIRELESS FOR PORCUPINE DISTRICT**

Portable Receiving and Sending Apparatus the Latest Development.

In a letter from Sandy Falls, Mr. M. J. Cavaney, who is fast gaining the reputation of being the wireless expert of the Porcupine, the writer asks for the discontinuance of his advertisement, at least until, he can get "caught up." "I have all I can handle for at least two months anyway," he says. Which is, of course, another proof that it pays to advertise, especially in The Porcupine Advance.

At present Mr. Cavaney is carrying on experiments at Sandy Falls in the development of a small portable sending and receiving wireless set for use among lumbermen, prospectors and mining engineers. Using the Sandy Falls station as a general receiving station and relaying to Timmins, it is expected that any person working in the bush anywhere within a radius of fifty miles from Timmins will be in constant touch with Timmins at all times. This is assuredly a very noteworthy development in the use of wireless and should prove of great value and service to the whole district. In this new country of big distances the development of wireless seems to be of special importance and as the pioneer here in this line Mr. Cavaney deserves the greatest encouragement, support and commendation.
