ANOTHER PDAN FOR THE COLONIZING OF THE NORTH

Here is another plan for the colonization and settlement of the North Land. Like all the other plans it has much in its favour and much against Annual Meeting of the Schumacher

The International Tourist Association has petitioned the Ontario Government for a grant in fee simple of ten townships, half of each of these southern part of Ontario. The object is to get settlers to go to the land in Northern Ontario, and the project has the backing of many mayors and wardens representing the organized counties and section of the other part of the province.

It is planned to first establish in each township on a farm of 160 acres a building suitable for municipal, residential, hospital and library purposes. 
