BROKER'S PARTY MUCH IMPRESSED BY NORTH

Party from Toronto, New York, Buffalo and Other Points Visited Porcupine

Recently representatives of the various offices of the Hamilton B. Wills brokerage business visited the North Land, and Mr. Wills and the other members of the party were greatly impressed with what they saw. In his last market letter Mr. Wills says that he saw enough to further convince him that "the mineral resources of this world-famed district are as yet but scratched and that for many years to come the production of gold and silver will continue to expand far beyond what was ever expected."

In the Porcupine the party were particularly impressed by the Hollinger, McIntyre and Schumacher. Mr. Wills refers to the McIntyre as a "mine of immensity," and speaks of the "amazing riches at depth." "The golden mile of the McIntyre" is also referred to, and the statement made that the mine has 60,000 tons of ore lying in the stopes broken and waiting to be sent to the mill. He estimates the value of this ore at \$700,000. He also suggests that the McIntyre ore reserves have been doubled in the past 15 months. Newray mine also comes in for favorable attention from the broker, who says the ore in the Hansen vein is identical with the McIntyre. He says that the Newray will show great values at depth, and thinks it will develop into one of the big mines of the Porcupine.

Cochrane has had three police chiefs in as many weeks. Chief Crawford resigned, and Chief Cox took over the duties on a Saturday and resigned inside of three or four days. The last new Chief is W. H. Benton, of North Bay. A man from North Bay, from what people say, should be quite glad to stay, at least for a day, in a North town where they, on the streets grow the hay, and sell it for pay, but this is getting too gay, so good night and hurrah!
