ONLY INCONCLUSIVE PEACE FOR AUSTRIANS

“Peace Without Victory,” the Verdict in Two Cases at Police Court

Thursday seemed to be a slow day, —also Austrian day,—at the Timmins police court. There were only two cases of any importance,—and in both Austrians seemed to figure,—and neither case got to any decided peace with victory finish. The first case was that of the two women who had such an exciting fight on Fourth Avenue last week. Each of the Austrian Amazons was charged with being disorderly. There was, however, no evidence against them, except, perhaps, what the one might say against the other. The Magistrate accordingly dismissed the case with the implied suggestion that the one could charge the other with assault and the second could charge the first with assault, and with this double dose of assault perhaps neither of them would feel so fresh and it might be possible to convict one or both of something unlawful.

In the other case Thursday, Joseph Shube was charged with the theft of a cow. According to the evidence the man laying the charge against him had made an agreement for the sale of the cow, conditional upon its being farrow. There was dispute between the witnesses as to what the agreement had been, and because Shube had “a color of right” to take the cow, the Magistrate could not find him guilty of theft. The Magistrate, however, suggested that the evidence seemed to point to the inference that the deal was not all above board, and he informed the complainant that if he felt he had been defrauded he could secure redress by taking the case to the Division Court where the agreement, etc., could be enquired into.

There were no liquor cases.
