**FORMER PORCUPINE  
MAN DEAD OVERSEAS**

Lytton Wilde, Formerly of the Dome and the Porcupine Crown, Make Supreme Sacrifice.

The following from the newspaper published at Redcliff, Alberta, will be of interest to many friends in this Camp. Lytton Wilde was employed at the Dome and the Porcupine Crown mines and during his stay in the Porcupine made many friends. The Redcliff paper in its issue of Nov. 29th says:—“With the fierce fighting which has been going on on the western front for the past few weeks, and with the number of men from this town and district now representing us on the several fronts, it is only natural to expect that we will also be represented on the lengthy casualty lists which are now being published from day to day. We have been last Monday word from the military department brought the sad news that Lytton Wilde, youngest son of Mrs. Wilde, of this town, had made the supreme sacrifice, having died from wounds previously reported. The other casualty was of Jack Walker, of the Box Springs district, who is reported missing.

“Young Wilde was only 21 years of age. Although he was a western lad, having been born here, he was in Toronto working when war broke out and he enlisted with the engineer corps of that city. He has been at the front for nearly three years, and had been three times gassed. Last summer he was awarded the military medal for keeping the lines of communication open at great risk of losing his life. Lytton was a fine stamp of young manhood. Although only twenty-one years of age he was well developed, and a strong healthy, fearless lad. Besides his widowed mother he also leaves a sister, Mrs. Roy Auger, and a brother, William, all of this district, to whom the sympathy of their many friends is extended in this terrible hour.”

**GUARD AGAINST FIRE  
RISKS AT CHRISTMAS**

Care Should be Taken in Regard to Decorations and Christmas Trees

The Canadian Fire Underwriters' Association, following its usual custom, has issued its yearly warning against the dangers to life and property from Christmas decorations, displays, trees, etc. This warning should be particularly heeded in this district where every fire is not only liable to do the usual damage but where it is also apparently used as a reason for continuing the high insurance rates. Not only is the use of certain inflammable materials liable to increase the danger of fires, but in some cases the very use of the materials may void the insurance policies should fire occur as a consequence. As the Fire Underwriters point out, the use of Christmas greens, harvest specimens and other inflammable materials such as draperies, sceneries, cotton to represent snow, and the like, (especially in connection with electric and other lighting systems), is decidedly an increase of hazard, it being impossible to make displays of that nature perfectly safe. The Underwriters also refer to the fact that the statutory conditions of a fire insurance policy read in part as follows:—“Any change material to the risk but without the control or knowledge of the assured shall void the policy as to the part affected thereby unless the change is promptly notified, in writing, to the Company or its local agent.” Merchants, householders, and others, should note the above and take heed of the threefold warning,—especially in this district,—for the protection of property, life and the fire insurance agreements.

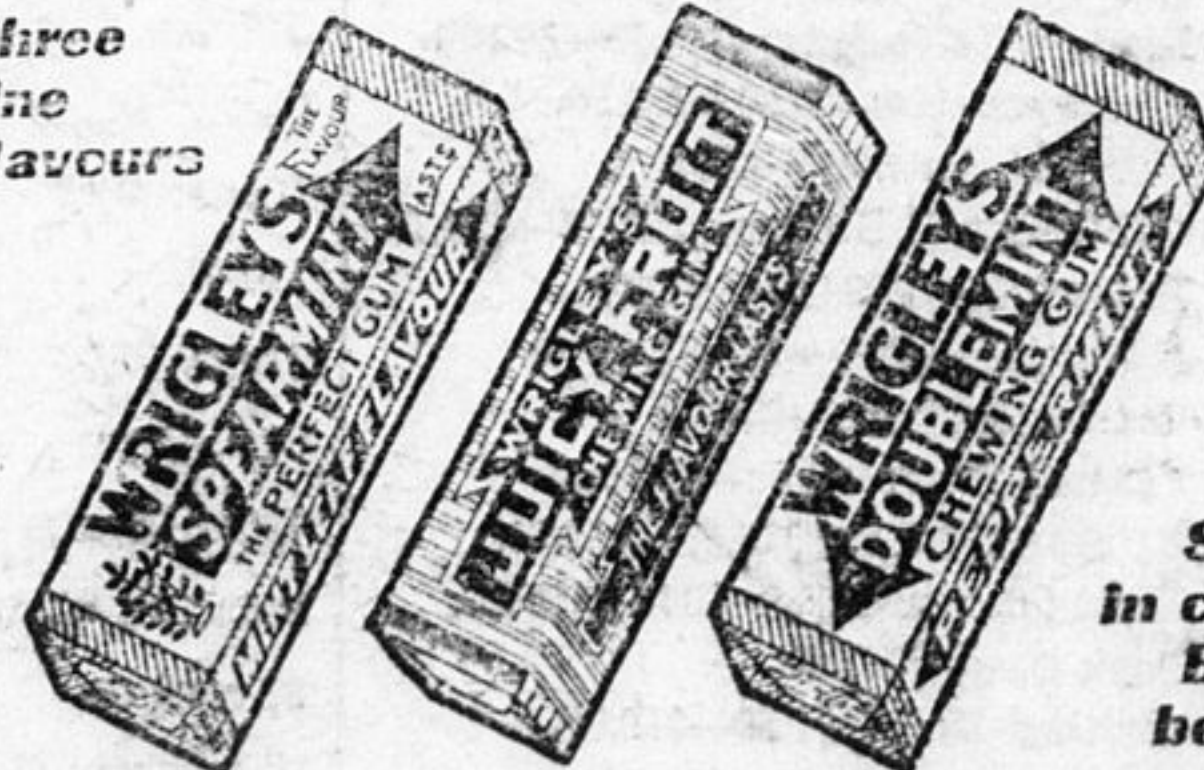
