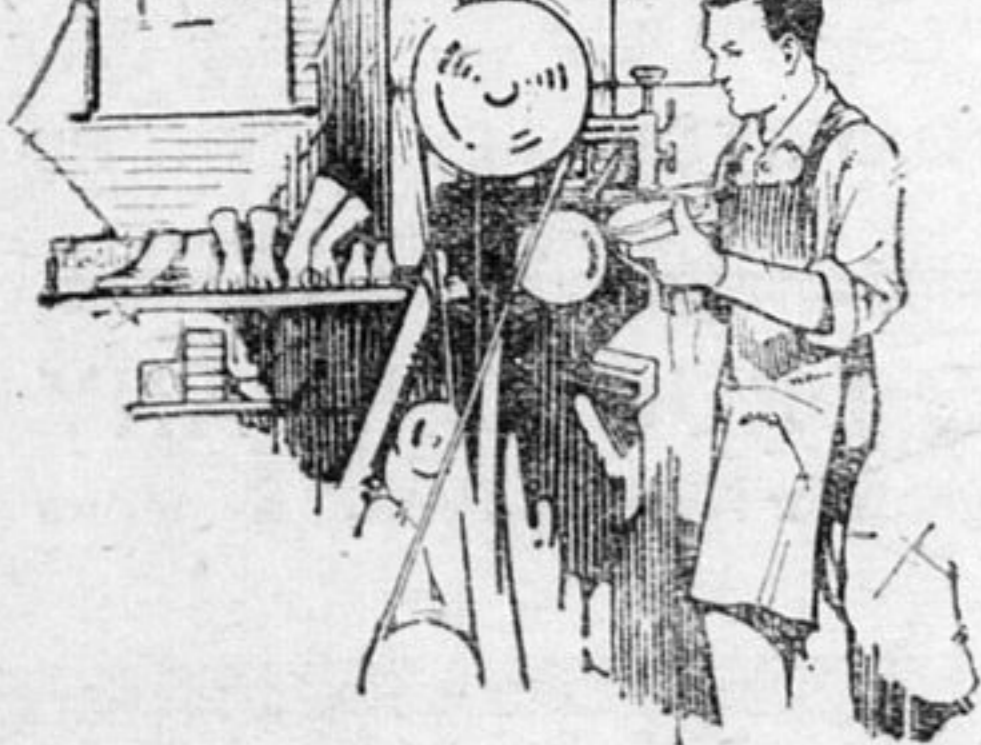

**PROVINCIAL HONOR FOR COBALT SCHOOL PRINCIPAL**

For the first time in its history Temiskaming has the honor of having one of its teachers elected to the presidency of the Public Schools section of the Ontario Educational Association. At the last meeting of the Ontario Educational Association which represents all the teachers of the Province, Mr. Bryson, principal of Cobalt Public School, was elected president of the Public Schools section. He was vice-president of this body last year.

**FIRE IN COBALT CAUSES CONSIDERABLE LOSS**

At about 8.30 Wednesday morning last week fire did considerable damage to two buildings on Lang street, Cobalt, the fire having much headway before an alarm was turned in. The origin of the fire is not known, but it is thought to have commenced in the Kestila building. The fire gutted this building and also the adjoining two-storey building. The upper storeys in each building were particularly damaged, the chief damage to the lower storeys being from water. The brigade made a quick response when summoned and Fire Chief Stinson was specially complimented by Mayor McKinnon on the good work done. The loss will be several thousand dollars. Every fire in this North Land should impress upon all the people in all towns the need for care and thought and attention to **PREVENT** fires. Even with the fire-fighting equipment of towns like Cobalt and Timmins Fire Prevention is away ahead of Fire Fighting. Every citizen should make it part of his religion to see that the property and lives of others are not endangered through his carelessness or thoughtlessness in the matter of guarding against the possibility of fire. Every citizen should view every fire up in this North Land as an added reason why he should be careful in things that make for the prevention of fires.

**ONTARIO SCHOOL TEACHERS AFTER BETTER SALARIES**

At the recent meeting of the Ontario Educational Association it was decided to carry on a campaign for increased salaries for the school teachers of the Province. It was considered by the Association that the minimum salary should be \$600.00. Absurd as it will appear to many, there are many teachers in Ontario working now for less than \$600.00 per year. That this is so, of course is a disgrace to the Province, but it is also undoubtedly a very pressing inconvenience to the teachers concerned. At a joint meeting of the Separate and Public School teachers of Cobalt last week the salary question was discussed. It was freely admitted that Cobalt was comparatively generous with its teachers in the matter of salary, but the same could not be said of all other places in the North Land. It was eventually decided by the Cobalt teachers that the minimum salary of teachers in the district north of Latchford should be at least \$800.00 per year, and the Co-operation of all the teachers of the North Land sought to have this minimum scale made effective. Mrs. Charlebois, Principal of the Cobalt Separate school, is secretary of the Committee in charge of the campaign, and teachers throughout the North Land are invited to write her for information or to pledge support to the campaign for fair salaries for the teachers.

**NORTH LAND LIBERALS TO FORM ASSOCIATION**

Under a plan approved by both the late leader, Sir Wilfred Laurier, and the present temporary leader, Mr. D. D. Mckenzie, the Liberals of Ontario are forming six district associations. One of these district associations will be known as the Northern Ontario Liberal Association. It will include Algoma, Nipissing and Temiskaming. A convention for the purpose of organization will take place in the Town Hall, North Bay, on Wednesday, June 4th. There will be morning and afternoon sessions for the adoption of a constitution and the election of officers. These meetings will not be open to the press. At the evening meeting the press and general public will be welcomed, and addresses are expected from Hon. Jacques Bureau, M.P., H. Hartley Dewar, K. C., M. P., Hon. Geo. P. Graham, and J. A. Robb, M. P., Chief Federal Liberal Whip.

The objects of the proposed District Association are given as being to assist the Riding Associations in the work of organization and in the promotion and development of the party principal and ideals. Suggested resolutions are invited and should be sent by mail to the secretary, Mr. John H. McDonald, Barrister, North Bay, not later than May 31st, in order that the Resolutions Committee may have ample opportunity to deal with them before the Convention.
