## NO POLITICS UP HERE BUT "THE NORTH LAND"

People in this District More Interested in North Land's Progress Than in Any Party's Fortunes.

Down in Old Ontario there are many men who make a regular religion of politics. Their fathers voted for a certain party, they vote for the same party, and their sons are expected to do the same. There are families who are born "Grit" or "Tory," live "Grit" or "Tory," and die in the same party faith. Issues and conditions have little effect on this solid vote; it is a sort of predestination. Up in this North Land, however, conditions have not favored this sort of hereditary political prejudice. In this new land there are so many pressing needs, and it is so imperative that particular attention be paid by the powers that be to the requirements of this land as some small return for the great wealth of forest and mine here opened up, that reasonable men realize that in view of the uncertainties and exigencies of politics, all in this great North must get together and work together in politics as in other things for the general good of the North. So the politics of the North Land may be summed up in the words, "For the North Land." The riding of Cochrane is not "solid" for any party; but it is "solid" for the advancement of the North Land. That is why there is such a general enthusiasm growing up for the election of Bob Potter. With Bob Potter, as the representative of the riding at Toronto, the district could rest assured that its interests would be well looked after. He would be in friendly touch with the Government, for even the most enthusiastic opti-

mists do not expect Dewart to win in Ontario this election. In addition, Bob Potter knows this land thoroughly. He has been here for sixteen years,—as a worker in the lumber woods, as a prospector, as a miner, as a farmer, and as a business man. He knows the needs, the problems and the prospects of the North from first-hand working experience. He could tell on the floor of the Legislature, in the Committee room, and to the Government Cabinet, exactly what are the pressing needs of the Big North Land. Most people will admit that in recent years the present Government has done much for this country, though much remains urgently demanding attention and action. None will deny the intelligent and careful interest shown by Hon. Mr. Ferguson, Minister of Lands, Forests and Mines, in the advancement of this district. Hon. Mr. Ferguson has shown a disposition to do everything possible for the North Land, and at the recent nomination of Mr. Potter he specially asked for the election of Mr. Potter so that he might be in close and official touch at all times with a man who so thoroughly knew the North and represented so completely the interests and the ambitions of this land. Because of all this, Conservative speakers suggest that a vote for Bob Potter is a vote for the North Land.

A jury in the High Court at Halleybury last week awarded John W. Snider, a Casey Township farmer, \$1,000.00 for injuries done to his land through the overflowing of slimes from the Casey-Cobalt Mining Company's mill. Snider wanted \$2500.00; some of the settlers in the district gave evidence to the effect that \$2,000.00 was a fair figure; while at least one witness put the damage considerable below these figures. The particular ground affected is bush land and rather low-lying.

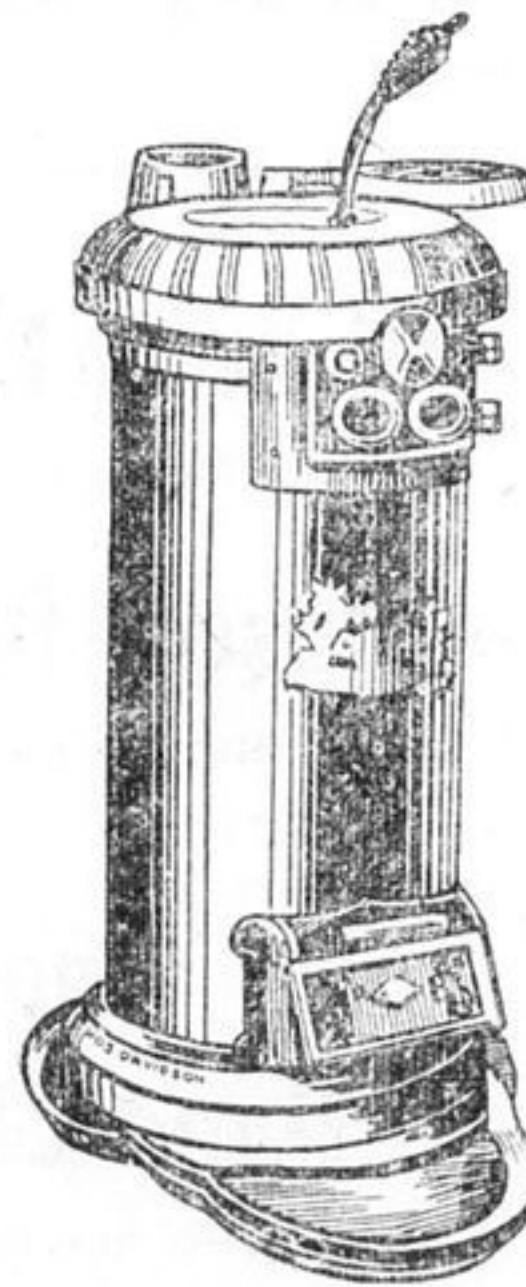

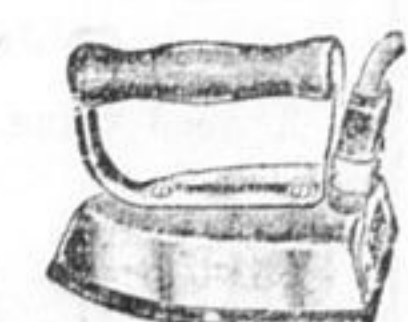
